**DO NOT FILL IN ITEM #** - numbers will be assigned by the auction committee.

Check items in at the Clubhouse on Saturday between 9:30 & 10:15AM. An auction committee member will determine whether your item(s) will be placed in the silent or live auction.

**Silent Auction:** Begins at the Clubhouse at 10:30AM and ends promptly at 11:30AM. Items purchased at silent auction will be distributed prior to live auction, but payment can be combined w/live auction purchases at the end of both auctions. Any items not bid on at silent auction will be returned to contributor.

**Live Auction:** Begins at 2:30PM, after the car races. Bring your checkbook or cash with you, as payment will be expected soon after auction closes.
